Jeff Berlin (track 5) is regarded as one of the most virtuosic **bassists** alive. In addition to numerous jazz-fusion and progressive rock solo albums, he has also recorded with artists like Allan Holdsworth, Bill Bruford, and KD Lang — and is reported to have turned down an offer to join Van Halen.

Dave Fiuczynski (track 5) is an iconoclastic jazz and rock **guitarist** and the leader of Screaming Headless Torsos. He has recorded with artists like Branford Marsalis, Me'Shell NdegeOcello, and John Zorn. He plays in Hiromi's band Sonicbloom.

Jon Herrera (track 1) is a **bassist** and former Editor of *Bass Player Magazine* where he wrote lessons, reviewed gear, and interviewed legendary musicians. He has played with Garaj Mahal, Oz Noy, Sir Mix-A-Lot, Miguel Migs, and many others.

Andrew Higgins (tracks 2, 4, 6-9) produces and plays **bass** in California. He has been a member of pit orchestras for numerous Broadway shows like *Wicked*, *The Lion King*, and *Rent* and tours regularly with Rita Moreno and Super Diamond.

Curt Moore (tracks 1 and 9) has played on more than 100 albums as a jazz and Latin **drummer**. He teaches at the Jazz School in Berkeley and has recorded with artists like Jimmy Heath, Chuck Berry, Bernadette Peters, and the Count Basie Orchestra.

Dave Weckl (track 5) is a world-renowned jazz-fusion **drummer** and bandleader. He has recorded with such artists as Paul Simon, Madonna, and Robert Plant, and has played regularly with Chick Corea's Akoustic and Elektric Bands.

Jake Wood (tracks 2, 4, 6-8) is a **drummer** and music journalist based out of San Francisco. He has played with artists like Joshua Redman, Diego's Umbrella, and Ol' Cheeky Bastards. He is one half of the electric funk-rock band Super Adventure Club.

Laurence Yeung (tracks 2-4, 6, 9) is a National Science Foundation Postdoctoral Fellow in Earth Sciences at UCLA by day—and a versatile jazz and rock **guitarist** by night. He plays regularly with Lounge-O-Rama and KJ Williams and the Conspirators.
